

RED *leg* 2005 Alentejo, Portugal



- Red *leg* is a blend of Shiraz and Aragones (also known as Tempranillo) grapes
- Created by Joao Portugal Ramos, one of the leading winemakers in Portugal
- The wine is named after the Redlegged partridge, a handsome and fullbodied bird inhabiting the Alentejo region of Portugal
- These birds are often seen amongst the vines of the vineyard
- Like the partridge, Red leg wine is also full-bodied and reveals spicy, red fruit
