

## RED leg 2005 Alentejo, Portugal



- **Red leg** is a blend of Shiraz and Aragones (also known as Tempranillo) grapes
- Created by Joao Portugal Ramos, one of the leading winemakers in Portugal
- The wine is named after the Red-legged partridge, a handsome and full-bodied bird inhabiting the Alentejo region of Portugal
- These birds are often seen amongst the vines of the vineyard
- Like the partridge, **Red leg** wine is also full-bodied and reveals spicy, red fruit
