THE WINE: Darien takes a thoroughly modern approach to Spanish winemaking. All of their wines are vinified in their newly-constructed, state-of-the-art winery with the utmost attention to detail. The Darien Rosé embodies the winemaker's philosophy perfectly—using the traditional grapes (tempranillo) of the region to make clean, modern-style wines.

TASTING NOTES: This deep pink wine from Rioja opens with a light tangerine-like bouquet with floral notes as well. On the palate, this light bodied wine is round, crisp, juicy and displays slightly tart cranberry like flavors. The finish is dry and lingers slightly.
